TRAINING DIRECTOR'S NEWS

LMS / Blended Learning: What is it? (Learning Management System) It's the new approach to apprenticeship classroom training. All IBEW/NECA apprenticeship programs across the country will phase this in with the first year apprentices starting September 2014. Apprentices will not buy student workbooks anymore, they will do their homework via computer/tablet/smart phone using enhanced media training that utilizes visual learning such as high quality media illustrations, animations, simulations, and video along with interactivity. This will free up more time for the instructor to deliver more hands on activities during class. The cost? It'll be cheaper if you already own a laptop/tablet since you no longer have to purchase the student workbooks. This will only be incorporated starting with the first year apprentices that starts schooling in September of 2014. The instructors (Steve, Barry) are in the process of preparing for the big change to ensure a smooth transition. All the other classes (2nd—5th) will remain the same.
