SCHOOL

There is a new starting time for all apprentices attending night school. The new hours will be **5:00 PM—9:00 PM**. The inside apprentices in years 3, 4, & 5 will be attending night school. There will not be any Saturday classes, but to make up the lost hours they will be attending classes on selected Monday nights. The school schedule has been mailed out and will be posted to the website.

Electrical Contest

School Payment

Monthly Work Reports

Want your raise on time? Be sure and submit your monthly OJT hours by the 10th of the following month. Failure to do so will delay your raise for at least 30 days. Don't throw your money away.

Missed School

Make sure you make up your missed school hours to avoid any penalties. Your hours must be made up within 90 days from the missed class date or before the start of the next semester if you're in day school, whichever comes first. For those that are night school, you have 90 days to make up the missed school hours from the missed class date.

TRAINING DIRECTOR'S NEWS

Changes at the JATC: Night school will be for the inside apprentices in their 3rd, 4th, and 5th year for the 2015-2016 school year. Day school will be for the 1st and 2nd year inside apprentices. There will not be anymore Saturday classes. Instead, they will be attending a few selected Monday nights. This will give everyone the weekends off.

CEU CLASS: Washington State requires that out of the 24 hours of CEU needed to renew your license, WAC/RCW (4hrs) and Code Change (8hrs) must be included. If you are renewing an Oregon license you must have the Oregon Rule & Law (4hrs) included in the 24 hours need for them. WAC/RCW does not work for your Oregon license renewal.
