TRAINING DIRECTORS NEWS

We finally have our solar arrays on the roof, and generating electricity. You should be able to see how much we generate daily, weekly and total to date on our web site soon. I want to thank the 5th year class on a job well done!!! The LMCC is offering to pay for the first 100 people that want to take the NABCEP Certificate of Knowledge exam. The cost of the exam is \$75. If you do not pass, you may retake at your own expense. You must have taken the Installer and Design class in order to be eligible for testing. Testing is held at our facility.

REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL: WAC/RCW—4 hrs, Code Change — 8 hrs. Your remaining 12 hours can be on anything that is recognized by the State of Washington. 1st Aid/CPR-AED will be a 8 hours class but only 4 hours of CEU's will be recognized by the State. Also the State will only recognize 12 hours maximum on any CEU classes regardless of the number of hours the class is registered for. In other words classes that are 16 hours or more (LonWorks, PLC.s) the State will only give you 12 hours of CEU's for your license renewal.

Enrollment begins:

September 15 9:00 AM

You must submit your deposit in order to be registered for the class. You can call the JATC office and sign up as long as we receive your deposit within 1 (one) week from the date you called. If we do not receive your deposit within one week, you will be removed from the roster.

Deposits (checks) shredded after completion of your class. If you fail to attend your class, we will cash your check!!
